



Information about Statewide and County Average Scores for the SACERS-U

On July 1, 2014, North Carolina Rated Assessment Project (NCRLAP) began using The School-Age Care Environment Rating Scale, Updated (SACERS-U) for school-age assessments for the star rated license system. At this time, there is not sufficient data to report statewide and county average scores for the updated tool. A summary will be created when enough assessments have been completed to compile the report.
